The GLS parcel delivery provider strengthens the transport network. New depot in Frýdek-Místek will increase transport capacity in the region of northern Moravia by 35%

In response to the past record Christmas season, the international parcel delivery provider GLS is strengthening its transport network and opening another depot in the Moravian-Silesian Region. The new depot in Frýdek-Místek has created up to 15 new jobs for couriers and will increase transport capacity in the region of northern Moravia by up to 35%. Delivery routes, and thus delivery times, will also be shortened. The carrier already operates 26 depots in the Czech Republic and plans to open two more this year.

Shortening delivery routes and new jobs

The transport company GLS has opened a new regional depot in Frýdek-Místek. The reason is the record number of packages transported last Christmas season. With the opening of this depot, GLS acquires another parcel logistics transport hub in the Moravian-Silesian Region. The new depot in this region will increase transport capacity by up to 35% and significantly shorten delivery routes. *"In the Czech Republic, we are constantly optimizing the transport network, we currently operate 26 depots and, in response to the extraordinary Christmas season last year, we plan to open two more. The new depot in Frýdek-Místek will increase our capacity in the Moravian-Silesian Region, shorten the current delivery routes approximately twice, which will not only result in faster delivery and greater comfort for parcel senders, but also significantly reduce emissions,"* explains Pavel Včela, director of GLS Czech Republic.
