GLS Poland with new locations on the map of Poland

GLS Poland has launched three new branches. Currently, this one of the largest courier companies in the country already has 50 branches, 5 of which opened this year.

Strengthened infrastructure in Warmia and Mazury, and an even denser network of points in Silesia. GLS branches have been joined by: Elblag, Jaworzno and Ogrodzieniec.

- Investment in infrastructure is an essential part of our business. Customers' expectations are always at the center of our activities, and thanks to the development of the network we are able to respond even more flexibly to the changing needs of the market, says Malgorzata Markowska, promotion & communication manager of GLS Poland. As she emphasizes, thanks to the new branches GLS will be even better prepared for the upcoming Christmas rush.

An important point in northern Poland

The newly opened branch in Elblag in the Warmian-Masurian province is an important location for GLS to increase efficiency in northern Poland. - The new branch will relieve the burden on the Olsztyn branch and will also have a major impact on the work of our points in the Pomeranian province. Elblag will take over some of the shipments that used to go to our Gdansk-Straszyn and Starogard-Rywałd locations," says Artur Antos, operations director for the East region. The daily capacity of the new branch is 2,100 parcels delivered and 1,150 parcels received. The new GLS branch is located in Elblag on Lotnicza Street. It has two unloading and loading gates, twenty courier gates, and the warehouse and office area of the facility is 1310 sqm.

Dynamic development in Silesia

GLS is also systematically expanding its network in Silesia. It is in Jaworzno

and Ogrodzieniec, the company has opened two more branches in this province. The first of these,

in Jaworzno, serves the Jaworzno, Mysłowice and Bukowno areas. In addition, thanks to its close proximity to the regional sorting facility in Czeladź, GLS will be able to carry out logistics processes in this area even more efficiently. The Jaworzno branch has two unloading and loading gates and seven courier gates, and the warehouse and office area is nearly 500 sqm. Starting



in January, GLS will further increase capacity in Jaworzno with a warehouse of an additional 1,000 sqm. It will have a total of 18 courier gates and three unloading and loading gates. Another newly opened GLS location in Silesia is Ogrodzieniec. This branch handles parcels from the areas of Dabrowa Górnicza, Klucze, Zawiercie, Ogrodzieniec, Pilica, Żarnowiec, and has a daily capacity of 1000 parcels delivered and 700 received. Thanks to the new branch, which is equipped with two unloading and loading gates and eight courier gates, the workload will be relieved at such GLS locations in Silesia as Czeladź

and Czestochowa.

- The opening of Jaworzno and Ogrodzieniec is another step in the strategy of surrounding the center of Silesia with local branches. These investments are to be kind of satellites taking care of the highest quality logistics and will be connected to the night sorting facility in Czeladz, which was launched in November. As a result, we are able to provide attractive receiving options for all companies located in Silesia. However, this is not yet our last word in the development of this region,"- says Michal Dojcz, operations director of the South region.

50 branches in Poland

GLS now has 50 locations on the map of Poland, following the launch of new branches. This year, the company opened as many as five new branches - in March in Zamosc and in October in Tarnowskie Góry. In the second quarter of last year, the GLS network expanded with branches

in Jelenia Góra, Wieluń, Krosno and Gryfice, and even earlier there were GLS locations near Starogard Gdański, north of Warsaw - in Różan near Ostrołęka, and in Wodzisław Śląski.

GLS in Poland also has nearly 5,000 Fast Parcel points in perfectly connected locations. The entire GLS Group network includes more than 120 distribution centers and about 1,600 branches in Europe and on the West Coast of the United States States and in Canada.
